

MCKENNA, Attorney General, and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and DONNA FAUVER, individual/employee having appeared *pro se*, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for LCB No. T-510, arising from Notice of Board Action on Tobacco Violation No. 4N9195A, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's Memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in Notice of Board Action On Tobacco Violation No. 4N9195A is sustained and within 30 days of the date of this Order, Ms. FAUVER shall view a responsible liquor and tobacco sales class via video/CD provided by Enforcement, and provide written proof of such viewing on a form provided by Enforcement. In the event Ms. FAUVER fails to provide proof of viewing a responsible liquor and tobacco

1 sales class within 30 days of this order, then the original penalty of fifty dollars shall be due to
2 the Board.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

INDIVIDUAL/EMPLOYEE

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General, and DONNA FAUVER, individual/employee, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number T-510, arising from Notice of Board Action on Tobacco Violation No. 4N9195A.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Enforcement Division issued to DONNA FAUVER Notice of Board Action on Tobacco Violation No. 4N9195A, alleging that on or about June 24, 2009, Ms. FAUVER sold tobacco products to a person under the age of eighteen, contrary to RCW 26.28.080.

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint, the parties have agreed to resolve this matter via settlement. Enforcement and Ms. FAUVER agree to the following:

1 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
2 litigation.

3 2. Ms. FAUVER explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
4 matters related to the above-referenced Notice of Board Action on Tobacco Violation.
5 Furthermore, Ms. FAUVER voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing in this matter.

6 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
7 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

8 4. Ms. FAUVER stipulates that sufficient facts exist for the Liquor Control Board
9 to sustain the violation set forth in Notice of Board Action on Tobacco Violation No.
10 4N9195A. Specifically, that on or about June 24, 2009, Ms. FAUVER sold tobacco products
11 to a person under the age of eighteen.

12 5. Ms. FAUVER agrees to view a responsible liquor and tobacco sales class via
13 video/CD provided by Enforcement, and to provide written proof of such viewing on a form
14 provided by Enforcement, no later than 30 days after the date of the Final Order of the Board.

15 6. If Ms. FAUVER fails to provide proof of viewing a responsible liquor and
16 tobacco sales class within 30 days of the Final Order of the Board, then the original penalty of
17 fifty dollars shall be due to the Board.

18 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
19 the WASHINGTON STATE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD.
