FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD



MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee BABY ISLAND INC. d/b/a SHORT STOP STORE-N-DELI having been represented by MARK WHITMAN (Licensee), and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for case number T-481, based on AVN No. 24059, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the violation set forth in AVN No. 24059 is sustained and within 30 days of the date of this Order, the Licensee shall pay a monetary penalty of fifty dollars (\$50.00) to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, 12501 NE 99th St, Suite A - 100 Vancouver, WA 98682. In the event that the Licensee does not make a full and timely

1 payment of the monetary penalty, then the Licensee shall pay the original standard penalty of
2 \$100.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and RUTH AMMONS, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee BABY ISLAND INC. d/b/a SHORT STOP STORE-N-DELI, represented by MARK WHITMAN (Licensee), hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number T-481, based on AVN No. 24059.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board issued Notice of Board Action on Tobacco Violation (AVN) No. 24059, alleging that on or about June 15, 2007, the above-named Licensee sold tobacco products to a person under the age of 18, contrary to RCW 26.28.080.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Prior to the filing of an administrative complaint in this matter, Enforcement and the
3 Licensee have agreed to enter into the following settlement concerning the above-referenced
4 Complaint. Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
6 expense of further litigation.

7 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
8 matters related to the above-referenced AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby voluntarily
9 withdraws its request for a hearing on this matter.

10 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
11 Agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

12 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above-referenced AVN. On
13 or about June 15, 2007, the above-named Licensee sold tobacco products to a person under the
14 age of 18, contrary to RCW 26.28.080.

15 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of fifty dollars (\$50.00) within
16 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment shall be sent to:

20 6. In the event that the Licensee does not make a full and timely payment of the
21 monetary penalty as required in Section II, Paragraph 5, then the Licensee shall pay the
