THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General and the licensee KPS GAS & GROCERIES, INC, d/b/a/ TOUCHET CHEVRON, represented by SHELLEY AJAX, Attorney for Licensee, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for case number T-490, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement, Enforcement's Memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, Enforcement's Memorandum recommending a Revised Proposed Final Order, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore:

1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the allegation set forth in AVN No. 23462 is sustained
2 and the Licensee shall:



3 (1) Purchase and use a point-of-sale system capable of reading official identification to
4 determine age; and

5 (2) Pay a monetary penalty of eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000). The monetary
6 penalty will be paid in four (4) installments of: (1) two thousand, five hundred
7 dollars (\$2,500) by October 31, 2008; (2) two thousand, five hundred dollars
8 (\$2,500) by November 28, 2008; (3) two thousand, five hundred dollars (\$2,500) by
9 December 31, 2008; and (4) three thousand, five hundred dollars (\$3,500) by
10 January 30, 2009.

11 All payments will be made to: Washington State Liquor Control Board, 2715 Saint Andrews
12 Loop, Ste. B, Pasco, WA 98301-3386. If the Licensee does not make a full and timely
13 payments of the monetary penalty, then the Licensee will forfeit any money paid, pay a
14 monetary penalty of one thousand dollars (\$1000), and serve a six (6) month suspension of its
15 tobacco license, the dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor
16 Control Board.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensee have agreed to resolve AVN No. 23462 via settlement.

3 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

4 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
5 litigation.

6 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
7 matters related to the above-referenced case and AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
8 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

9 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
10 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in AVN No. 23462. Specifically,
12 on or about December 28, 2007, an employee of the above-named Licensee sold a tobacco
13 product to a person under the age of 18, in violation of RCW 26.28.080.

14 5. The Licensee agrees to purchase and use a point-of-sale system capable of
15 reading official identification to determine age, and it will pay a monetary penalty of eleven
16 thousand dollars (\$11,000). The monetary penalty will be paid in four (4) installments of: (1)
17 two thousand, five hundred dollars (\$2,500) by October 31, 2008; (2) two thousand, five
18 hundred dollars (\$2,500) by November 28, 2008; (3) two thousand, five hundred dollars
19 (\$2,500) by December 31, 2008; and (4) three thousand, five hundred dollars (\$3,500) by
20 January 30, 2008. All payments will be sent to:


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1 6. In the event that the Licensee fails to make full and timely payments as required
2 in Section II, Paragraph 5, the Licensee will forfeit any money paid, pay a monetary penalty of
3 one thousand dollars (\$1000), and serve a six (6) month suspension of its tobacco license, the
4 dates and time of which shall be set by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


5 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by


