



STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

LICENSE NO. (UBI) 6016903290010001

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and JENNIFER ELIAS, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, 99 CENTS ETC (Licensee), represented by Ms. Mehret Berhane, owner, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number T-492.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Licensee in its Complaint dated April 23, 2008, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about February 2, 2008, the above-named Licensee, and/or an employee thereof, sold, or permitted to be sold, a tobacco product to a person under the age of 18 years, contrary to RCW 26.28.080 and WAC 314-10-050.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

3 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
4 litigation.

5 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
6 matters related to the above-referenced complaint. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
7 voluntarily withdraws her request for a hearing in this matter.

8 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
9 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

10 4. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above complaint.
11 Specifically, on or about February 2, 2008, the Licensee sold a tobacco product to a person
12 under the age of 18, in violation of RCW 26.28.080 and WAC 314-10-050.

13 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a monetary penalty of fifty-dollars (\$50.00) and
14 provide proof of viewing a training video or attending a Liquor Board class on responsible
15 liquor and tobacco sales within 30 days of the date of the Final Order of the Board. Payment

20 6. If the Licensee fails to provide proof of attending or viewing a responsible
21 liquor and tobacco sales class or fails to pay the monetary penalty of fifty dollars within 30
22 days of the Final Order of the Board, then the original penalty of one hundred dollars shall be
23 due to the Board.
