

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee, GIRMA G. WOLDEMARIAM, Individual, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for case number T-501 arising from Administrative Violation Notice (AVN) No. 14518.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board charged the above-named Individual in its Complaint dated September 3, 2008, with the following violation of the Washington State Liquor Act:

On or about June 3, 2008, the above-named Individual, sold/supplied tobacco to a person under the age of eighteen (18), contrary to RCW 26.28.080 and WAC 314-10-050.

2. Enforcement and Mr. Woldemariam wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced Complaint.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
3 litigation.

4 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
5 matters related to the above-referenced case and AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
6 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

7 3. This Agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
8 Agreement, and it is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

9 4. On or about June 3, 2008, GIRMA WOLDEMARIAM, sold/supplied tobacco
10 to a person under the age of eighteen (18), contrary to RCW 26.28.080 and WAC 314-10-050.

11 5. Mr. Woldemariam agrees to attend a Liquor Control Board Enforcement
12 Division Tobacco Education and Prevention Class by January 30, 2009. Mr. Woldemariam
13 understands that classes are held the first and third Wednesdays of every month in Seattle or
14 the second and fourth Tuesdays of every month in Tukwila.

15 6. In the event that the Licensee fails to attend a class by January 30, 2009, Mr.
16 Woldemariam will pay a fifty dollar (\$50) monetary penalty to the Washington State Liquor
17 Control Board at P.O. Box 43094, Olympia, WA 98504.


1 7. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
