FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

THIS MATTER having come before the Washington State Liquor Control Board (Board) and the Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division having been represented by its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and Brian J. Considine, Assistant Attorney General, and Gurmej Singh (Representative for Licensee), SUPER C II, INC d/b/a SUPER C, and the parties having voluntarily entered into a stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. T-516, arising from Tobacco Violation Notice (TVN) No. 14346/4Q9014D, and the Board having considered the stipulated settlement agreement and Enforcement's memorandum recommending acceptance of the stipulated settlement agreement, and the Board having had the opportunity to review the file materials maintained in this case, now therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulated Settlement Agreement for Case Number T-516 is approved and that the violation set forth in Tobacco Violation Notice No. 14346/4Q9014D is sustained.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced violation is the fourth violation of its kind in a two-year period, and carries a penalty of a one thousand five hundred dollar (\$1,500) monetary penalty and a one-year suspension of its tobacco license.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that there shall be no suspension or monetary penalty associated with this violation because the Licensee has sold the business and no longer operates under the license. The violation will be a matter of record, and may be considered by the Board if the Licensee applies for a tobacco license in the future.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and BRIAN J. CONSIDINE, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee, SUPER C II, INC. d/b/a SUPER C (Licensee) of Spokane, Washington, through its representative, GURMEJ SINGH, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. T-516.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Washington State Liquor Control Board, by Complaint, alleged that on or about January 14, 2009, the above-named Licensee, sold/supplied tobacco to a person under the age of eighteen (18), contrary to RCW 26.28.080 and is subject to the penalties set out in RCW 70.155.100(3) and (4).

2. Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the above-referenced Complaint.

1 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

2 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

3 1. The parties enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further
4 litigation.

5 2. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative review of all
6 matters related to the above-referenced case and AVN. Furthermore, the Licensee hereby
7 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

8 3. The Licensee admits to the violation set forth in the above-referenced
9 Complaint. Specifically, on or about January 14, 2009, the above-named Licensee,
10 sold/supplied tobacco to a person under the age of eighteen (18).

11 4. The Licensee admits that Super C II, Inc. d/b/a Super C has discontinued its
12 business.

13 5. The parties agree that the above-referenced violation is the fourth violation of
14 its kind in a two-year period, and carries a standard penalty of a one thousand, five hundred
15 dollar (\$1,500) monetary penalty and a one-year suspension of its tobacco license. However,
16 the parties agree that the suspension is no longer a viable option, as the Licensee has
17 discontinued its business, and the one thousand, five hundred dollar (\$1,500) monetary penalty
18 should be waived. The parties therefore agree that there will be no assessment of any fees or
19 suspension associated with this violation.

20 6. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
21 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

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1 7. This settlement agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the
2 terms of this agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms, and shall be
3 effective when signed by all parties and/or their legal representatives.
