
1 above-captioned matters and further that the violations set forth and charged in the Complaints

The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General and the Licensee KYOHEE, INC. d/b/a CIGAR ZONE hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No's. T-525 and T-526.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division charged the above-named Licensee and also charged the individual employee Kyo Hee Keum, in Tobacco Violation Notice (TVN) No. 1Q0181A/32232, with the following alleged violation of the Washington State Liquor Control Board rules and regulations:

1 That on or about June 30, 2010, the above-named Licensee and individual employee,
2 sold/supplied tobacco to a person under the age of eighteen (18), contrary to RCW 26.28.080
3 and is subject to the penalties set out in RCW 70.155.100.

4 Enforcement and the Licensee and individual employee wish to enter into a settlement
5 agreement concerning the above-referenced TVN.

6 II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

7 Enforcement and the Licensee and individual employee agree to the following:

8 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and
9 expense of further litigation. The Licensee and individual employee explicitly waives the right
10 of further administrative review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and
11 TVN. The Licensee and individual employee hereby voluntarily withdraw their requests for a
12 hearing in both these matters.

13 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this
14 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

15 3. The Licensee and individual employee admit the violation set forth above and
16 referenced in the complaint: That on or about June 30, 2010, the above-named Licensee and
17 individual employee, sold/supplied tobacco to a person under the age of eighteen (18), contrary
18 to RCW 26.28.080 and is subject to the penalties set out in RCW 70.155.100.

19 4. The Licensee and individual employee acknowledge this is the Licensee's
20 second violation of this type within a twenty four month period, which carries a standard monetary
21 penalty of three hundred dollars (\$300) for the licensee and one hundred dollars (\$100) for the
22 individual employee.

23 5. The Licensee agrees to pay a total monetary penalty of two hundred dollars
24 (\$200) for the above-referenced violation. The individual employee agrees to pay a total
25 monetary penalty of seventy-five dollars (\$75) for the above-referenced violation. The amount
26 shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the final order of the Washington State

1 Liquor Control Board. Payment shall be made to "Washington State Liquor Control Board" no
2 later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable date.


3 6. In the event that the Licensee or individual employee does not make a timely
4 payment, as required by Section II, ¶5, the Licensee or individual employee shall pay the full
5 monetary penalty, pursuant to RCW 70.155.100; the dates and times of which shall be set by
6 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.

7 7. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
8 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
9 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced
10 Complaint.

11 8. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by
12 the Washington State Liquor Control Board.


