


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED the Board accepts, adopts, and incorporates herein by reference the Stipulated Settlement Agreement between Enforcement and the Licensee in the above-captioned matter and further that the violation set forth in Tobacco Violation Notice No. 34458 served on May 26, 2011 is sustained. Pursuant to the terms of the settlement agreement, it is further ordered that the Licensee shall pay a total monetary penalty of


1 ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in four (4) separate payments, and shall have all employees
2 complete training on the sale of tobacco, to be provided at no cost by the Liquor Control Board
3 within sixty (60) days after entry of this Final Order of the Board, and the Licensee shall install
4 equipment software with the existing cash register system to require the entry of date of birth
5 for every tobacco sale (within thirty (30) days after entry of this Final Order). In the event the
6 Licensee fails to comply with any requirement of the stipulated settlement agreement as
7 adopted by this Final Order, then the standard penalty shall be imposed.

STIPULATED SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

The Washington State Liquor Control Board (LCB) Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and H & J TAKHAR, L.L.C. d/b/a THE GENERAL STORE, through its representative, JAY TAKHAR, hereby enter into this Stipulation and Settlement Agreement for LCB case No. T-540.

I. INTRODUCTION

In LCB case No. T-540, the Enforcement Division of the Washington State Liquor Control Board served the licensee with TVN No. 34458 on May 26, 2011. In a Complaint dated July 20, 2011, the LCB charges that on or about May 26, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or employees thereof, sold/supplied tobacco to a person under the age of eighteen (18) contrary to RCW 26.28.080, which is alleged as the third violation of its type within a two (2) year period, and is subject to the penalties set out in RCW 70.155.100.

II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES

Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and expense of further litigation.

1 7. The Licensee agrees to have all employees complete training on the sale of
2 tobacco, to be provided at no cost by the Liquor Control Board within sixty (60) days after
3 entry of the Final Order of the Board. The Licensee also agrees to install equipment or
4 software with the existing cash register system that will require the entry of the date of birth for
5 every tobacco sale (within thirty (30) days after entry of the Final Order of the Board).

6 8. In the event that the Licensee does not fully and timely satisfy the penalties and
7 conditions set forth in Section II, Paragraph 6 & 7, then the standard penalty shall be imposed.

8 9. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are
9 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full
10 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced
11 Complaint.


12 10. The parties recognize that this settlement agreement is subject to approval by


