FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD

TOBACCO VIOLATION NO. 2Y1168A

The above-captioned matter coming on regularly before the Board, and it appearing that:

1. The Board issued a formal Complaint dated July 25, 2011 alleging that on or about June 9, 2011, the above-named Individual, sold/supplied tobacco to a person under the age of eighteen (18), contrary to RCW 26.28.080 and is subject to the penalties set out in RCW 70.155.100 (3) & (4); and
2. The Individual timely submitted a request for an administrative hearing; and
3. A Pre-Hearing Conference was scheduled for 1:00 p.m. on November 28, 2011 before Administrative Law Judge Leslie Birnbaum with the Office of Administrative Hearings; and
4. The Education and Enforcement Division of the Board was represented by Assistant Attorney General Timothy Ford appeared as scheduled; and
5. The Individual failed to appear as scheduled, and failed to make a timely request for a continuance; and
6. On December 1, 2011 Administrative Law Judge Leslie Birnbaum entered her Initial Order of Default Dismissing (Appellant's) Appeal for Failure to Appear which dismissed the appeal; and
7. No motion to vacate the default order was received; and

The entire record in this proceeding was presented to the Board for final decision, and the Board having fully considered said record and being fully advised in the premises; NOW THEREFORE; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge's Initial Order of Default Dismissing (Appellant's) Appeal for Failure to Appear is adopted as the Final Order of the Board.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Complaint filed in this case is sustained and the above-named Individual shall pay the monetary penalty of fifty dollars (\$50) within 30 days of this order. Failure to comply with the terms of this order will subject the Individual to further disciplinary action.



Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which relief is requested. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering it directly to the Washington State Liquor Control Board, Attn: Kevin McCarroll, 3000 Pacific Avenue Southeast, PO Box 43076, Olympia, WA 98504-3076, with a

copy to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt of the document at the Board's office. RCW 34.05.010(6). A copy shall also be sent to Mary M. Tennyson, Senior Assistant Attorney General, 1125 Washington St. SE, P.O. Box 40110, Olympia, WA 98504-0110. A timely petition for reconsideration is deemed to be denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on the petition. An order denying reconsideration is not subject to judicial review. RCW 34.05.470(5). The filing of a petition for reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for judicial review.

Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not stay the effectiveness of this Order. The Board has determined not to consider a petition to stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such request should be made in connection with a petition for judicial review under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V, Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement. The petition for judicial review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Board, the Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty days after service of the final order, as provided in RCW 34.05.542.


