The Washington State Liquor Control Board Education and Enforcement Division (Enforcement) represented by its attorneys ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General and TIMOTHY D. FORD, Assistant Attorney General, and the Licensee ENUBIE CORPORATION d/b/a SMOKE TIME PLUS, represented by WARREN CHINN, attorney for Licensee, hereby enter into this stipulated settlement agreement for Liquor Control Board Case No. T-555.

**I. INTRODUCTION**

The Washington State Liquor Control Board, Enforcement and Education Division served the above-named Licensee, in Tobacco Violation Notice (TVN) No. 34308, alleging that: On or about December 4, 2011 the Licensee or employee(s) thereof sold tobacco products to a person under the age of eighteen (18) years in violation of RCW 26.28.080. The TVN shows a two (2) year violation history and is cited as the second violation of its kind, which reflects a three hundred dollar (\$300) penalty.

1 Enforcement and the Licensee wish to enter into a settlement agreement concerning the  
2 above-referenced TVN.

3 **II. AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES**

4 Enforcement and the Licensee agree to the following:

5 1. Enforcement and the Licensee enter into this agreement to avoid the time and  
6 expense of further litigation. The Licensee explicitly waives the right of further administrative  
7 review of all matters related to the above-referenced violation and TVN. The Licensee hereby  
8 voluntarily withdraws its request for a hearing in this matter.

9 2. This agreement constitutes the final written expression of all the terms of this  
10 agreement and is a complete and exclusive statement of these terms.

11 3. The Licensee stipulates to the violation set forth above and referenced in the  
12 TVN: On or about December 4, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or employee(s) thereof sold  
13 tobacco products to a person under the age of eighteen (18) years in violation of  
14 RCW 26.28.080.

15 4. The Licensee acknowledges this is the Licensee's second violation of this type  
16 within a twenty-four (24) month period, which carries a standard monetary penalty of three  
17 hundred dollars (\$300).

18 5. In consideration of and for this settlement agreement, the Licensee agrees to pay  
19 a total monetary penalty of two hundred dollars (\$200). The Licensee shall pay the monetary  
20 penalty no later than thirty (30) days after entry of the Final Order of the Board.

21 **Payments shall be made out to the Washington State Liquor Control Board** no  
22 later than 4:00 p.m. on the applicable dates and sent to:

25 6. The Licensee agrees to have all employees' complete training on the sale of  
26 tobacco, to be provided at no cost by the Liquor Control Board within thirty (30) days after

2 future employees. Training that has been completed prior to this agreement but after the date  
3 of violation will satisfy the requirement of this paragraph.


4 7. In the event that the Licensee does not fully and timely satisfy the penalties and  
5 conditions set forth in Section II, Paragraph 5 and 6, then the standard penalty shall be imposed  
6 as stated in Paragraph 4.

7 8. The undersigned parties declare that the terms of this Settlement Agreement are  
8 completely read, wholly understood, and voluntarily accepted for the purpose of making a full  
9 and final compromise and settlement of any and all claims arising from the above referenced  
10 TVN.






