SUBJECT: Repeal of correspondence dated June 16, 1998

This document is being provided to the Board to seek a repeal of the attached interoffice correspondence dated June 16, 1998 subject: Agency request for class F/grocery store license for wine sale. In part, the interoffice correspondence states that all wine purchased by a contract liquor store must be obtained only from the Washington State Liquor Control Board (WSLCB).

To support the new contract direction and to provide clarification, contract liquor stores can now purchase their wine and/or beer from the Liquor Control Board without obtaining a beer and/or specialty shop license; and therefore the provisions of Chapter 66.24.371 RCW, do not apply. However a contract liquor store that chooses to purchase their beer and/or wine from a distributor must obtain a beer and/or wine specialty shop license in accordance with Chapter 66.24.371 RCW.

The repeal would only impact those contract liquor stores that choose to purchase their beer or wine from a source other than the Liquor Control Board. In addition, each contract liquor store would need to adhere to Section C part 17 of the contract liquor store contract issued on May 6, 2011. This would require the contract liquor stores to designate their choice to purchase from a distributor or the WSLCB.

SUBJECT: AGENCY REQUEST FOR CLASS F/GROCERY STORE LICENSE FOR WINE SALES

If approved this license would allow the Agency to purchase wine from licensed wine wholesalers and be sold by the Agency at retail prices differing from those established by the Board.
