



NOTICE OF RULE MAKING – Pre-proposal #13-15

The Washington State Liquor Control Board has entered into the initial stage of rulemaking to draft rules for:

Beer/Wine Sampling at Farmer’s Markets (new rules)
Craft distilleries Selling to consumers (revised rule)

Rules are needed to implement two bills passed in the 2013 legislative session:

- **SB 5674 – Beer/Wine Sampling at Farmer’s Markets**
- **HB 1149 – Craft Distilleries Selling to Consumers**
