



NOTICE OF RULE MAKING – Pre-proposal - #14-22

The Washington State Liquor Control Board has entered into the initial stage of rule making (CR 101) to revise rules in the following WACs:

- **314-24-161 Domestic wineries and wine distributors.**
- **314-02-015 What is a spirits, beer, and wine restaurant?**
- **314-02-041 What is a hotel license?**
- **314-02-045 What is a beer and/or wine restaurant?**
- **314-02-070 What is a tavern license?**
- **314-02-105 What is a beer and/or wine specialty store license?**

Rules are needed to implement the following legislation passed in the 2014 legislative session:

- **SHB 1742 – Wine Growlers**
- **SSB 6442 – Cider Growlers**
