Notice of Permanent Rules for Outside Service Requirements

This explanatory statement concerns the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board's adoption of the revisions to WAC 314-02-130 What types of changes to a licensed premises require board approval?

The Administrative Procedure Act (RCW 34.05.325(6)) requires agencies to complete a concise explanatory statement before filing adopted rules with the Office of the Code Reviser. This statement must be provided to anyone who gave comment about the proposed rulemaking.

Once persons who gave comment during this rulemaking have had a chance to receive this document, the Liquor and Cannabis Board will file the amended rules with the Office of the Code Reviser. These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing (approximately October 22, 2016).
