

Global ID Structure

WAG123456.PL1A3XQ

First two characters represent the State abbreviation

Third character represents the type of licensed facility from which the record was generated

Characters four through nine are the licensee ID

A period creates a visual separation within the number

The first two letters after the period are an abbreviation for the type of global ID record

The letters and numbers following the record abbreviation code are the "unique" part...these are generated by Leaf Data Systems

Licensed Facility Codes

- G = Producer
- M = Processor
- J = Producer/Processor
- R = Retailer
- Z = Transporter
- T = Tribe
- E = Coop
- L = Testing Laboratory*

*Not officially a "licensed cannabis facility", but treated as one for purposes of lab result entry

Common Global ID Type Abbreviations

- AR = Area
- BA = Batch
- DI = Disposal
- IN = Inventory Lot
- IT = Inventory Transfer
- LR = Lab Result
- PL = Plant
- SA = Sale
- ST = Strain
- US = User
