Draft proposed changes to WAC 314-55-097

- 1. Amended language to define "cannabis waste" for the purposes of WAC 314-55-097 to mean "cannabis waste" means solid waste generated during cannabis production or processing. "Cannabis waste" does not include "hemp" or "industrial hemp," as defined in RCW 15.140.020.
- Amended language to allow sales of cannabis waste by a licensed producer or processor under certain conditions, including report sales information to WSDA and LCB prior to completion of the sale.
- Maintains current requirements for grinding and disposal of cannabis waste that is not sold.
- 4. Requires recordkeeping for audit purposes. Violations are subject to penalty.
