



**Bill Title: Retail Liquor Licenses Omnibus Legislation – Fact Sheet 4 of 6**  
**Issue: Allowing a Microbrewery Second Location**  
**Bill Number: E2SSB 5859**  
**Amends RCW 66.24.244 (5)**

**Background:**

Part of the retail liquor licenses omnibus legislation. Allows a microbrewery licensee holding either a Spirits/Beer/Wine or a Beer/Wine restaurant license on the microbrewery premises to obtain a second retail license at another location. This endorsement goes into effect July 22, 2007.

RCW 66.24.244 (5) now reads in part:

“If the microbrewery licensee holds a separate license for a spirits, beer, and wine restaurant or a beer and/or wine restaurant, operated on the brewery premises, the licensee may hold a second retail license for a spirits, beer, and wine restaurant or a beer and/or wine restaurant, at a location separate from the licensed brewery premises.”

**Implementation:**

If a microbrewery licensee holding a Spirits/Beer/Wine Restaurant or a Beer/Wine Restaurant license wants to add a second retail license at a location other than the brewery premises, they must:

- Complete and submit a Master Application and appropriate fees to Master License Service.
- The regular application process will apply. Average processing time for a new application is 60 to 90 days.
