



Bill Title: Alcohol in Non-Beverage Form
Bill Number: HB 2825
Effective Date: June 12, 2008
New Section: Adds new section to RCW 66.12

Background

This bill allows the holder of a Class 1 or Class 2 alcohol permit to purchase non-beverage alcohol directly from suppliers rather than purchasing through the Board.

Class 1 alcohol permit holders include physicians, dentists, persons in charge of an institution regularly conducted as a hospital or sanitarium, or a home devoted exclusively to the care of seniors.

Class 2 alcohol permit holders include persons engaged in a mechanical or manufacturing business, or in scientific pursuits requiring the use of alcohol.

Implementation:

The application for both Class 1 and Class 2 permits is posted on the WSCLB Web site at www.liq.wa.gov (form LIQ 354-50-10/03). People needing to purchase non-beverage alcohol for their business must submit the application and fee to the WSLCB Licensing Division.

- Class 1 alcohol permit fee is \$5.
- Class 2 alcohol permit fee is \$5 to purchase 5 gallons or less, or \$10 to purchase more than 5 gallons.

After receiving the application and fee, the Liquor Control Board Licensing Division will mail an approval letter with the permit number to the licensee. Suppliers will require the permit number before accepting orders.
