



Bill Title: Alcohol tasting by students
Bill Number: HB 1004
Effective Date: July 24, 2015
Amends: RCW 66.20.010; and 66.44.270

Summary:

This bill adds to those entities qualified to receive a special permit from the Liquor Control Board:

- Regional and state universities to the list of eligible educational institutions authorized for the tasting of alcoholic beverages by underage students enrolled in specified culinary or alcoholic beverage technology classes.
- Eligible sommelier, wine business, enology, and viticulture degree programs to the types of degree programs authorized for the tasting of alcoholic beverages by underage students.

How to Apply:

Complete the Application for a Class 15 Permit to allow tasting of alcohol by persons at least 18 years of age under certain conditions. The application can be found on the WSLCB website at: <http://lcb.wa.gov>.

When the WSLCB Licensing Division receives the application:

- A Customer Service Specialist will be assigned to the application.
- The Customer Service Specialist will verify the applicant is a community, technical college, or regional or state university.
- The Customer Service Specialist will send the applicant an approval letter.
