



During the week of July 11th, tobacco retailers should have a received a 2 page handout that includes information on the new state and federal laws and regulations concerning vapor products/electronic nicotine delivery systems (also known as ENDS). We have since received feedback from some retailers that more information and clarification about flavored tobacco products would be helpful. In response, we have revised the previously sent handout and postcard. Please use the attached versions to share with retailers and your communities.

The information made for retailers has been translated into Spanish and Korean. The revised Spanish and Korean 2 page handout and postcard will be sent out via the listserv early next week, and will also be made available via the LCB website, lcb.wa.gov.

## What are the laws around selling flavored tobacco products?

- □ **Tobacco products** include cigarettes, cigars, loose or roll-your-own tobacco, hookah or pipe tobacco, smokeless tobacco, and dissolvable tobacco.
- □ **Vapor products/ENDS** include electronic cigarettes, vape pens, and all similar products and devices, including all the parts, even if sold separately. This includes the e-liquid used in vapor products, whether or not it contains nicotine.
- □ **Don't** sell flavored cigarettes or flavored roll-your-own tobacco. You can sell menthol flavored cigarettes and menthol flavored roll-your-own tobacco.
- ☐ You can sell flavored e-liquid, cigars, smokeless tobacco, hookah tobacco ("shisha"), little cigars, and dissolvable tobacco products (e.g., strips and orbs), as well as flavored component parts (e.g., blunt wraps).

## Please Remember:

The buyer must be 18 years of age and born on or before today's date in 1998 in order to purchase tobacco in 2016. Always check a valid form of ID for anyone who appears under the age of 27.
