The regular meeting of the Washington State Liquor Control Board was called to order at 3:00 p.m., on Tuesday, November 22, 2005 in the Board conference room, 3000 Pacific Avenue S.E., Olympia, Washington, by Chairman Merritt D. Long. Board Member Roger Hoen and Vera Ing were present. Tony Kim, Administrative Assistant to the Board summarized the minutes.

Financial Services Division - Years of Service Recognition

Mr. Simmons recognized Mike Wolfe, Support Services Manager for his 30 years of dedicated service to the State.

Retail Services Division – Contract Liquor Store Manager Selection, CLS #599, Leavenworth; Jamie Storm, District Manager

Leavenworth is a town in Chelan County on Highway 2, the Stevens Pass highway. The population is approximately 2,180 and with the surrounding areas 12,000. The nearest Contract Liquor Store is CLS #611 Skykomish which is 30 miles away. The gross sales for 2005 were \$1.2 million and the commission was \$97,000.

Twenty-five applications were requested, twenty-one were completed and returned, and twelve were interviewed. The interview panel consisted of: Jamie Storm, District Manager, Lori LeMay, District Manager, and Greg Wood, Auditor for Chelan County. After the interviews were completed the selected candidate was Julie Ganas.

Julie is a 4 year resident of Leavenworth. She is a small business owner and accountant. She formerly was a staff accountant for a small firm in Spokane. She holds two degrees from Eastern Washington University in accounting and Information Systems.

Julie plans to continue in the current site and sell clothing as well as liquor. She plans to purchase fixtures, and the POS. She plans to add lighting and exterior signage. She will work the outlet full time and hire a second employee to help with ship day and busy times. She is organized and had a well-rounded business plan.

References were stellar from her prior supervisor and a former co-worker at LeMasters and Daniels CPA.

Mr. Storm recommended the appointment of Julie Ganas as the new Contract Liquor Store Manager for the Leavenworth Contract Store, effective January 1, 2006.
