**Subject:** **Approval for filing a pre-proposal statement of inquiry (CR 101) to review WAC 314-11-070 relating to liquor service hours**

The city of Seattle submitted a petition to the board to open rulemaking to adopt new rules governing the establishment of extended hours service areas within local jurisdictions.

**Process**

The Rules Coordinator requests approval to file the pre-proposal statement of inquiry (CR 101) for the rule making described above. An issue paper on this rule was presented at the Board meeting on October 12, 2011, and is attached to this order.

If approved for filing, the tentative timeline for the rule making process is outlined below:

October 12, 2011	Board is asked to approve filing the pre-proposal statement of inquiry (CR 101)
November 7, 2011	Code Reviser publishes notice, LCB sends notice to rules distribution list
December 1, 2011	End of written comment period
December 7, 2011	Board is asked to approve filing the proposed rules (CR 102 filing)
December 21, 2011	Code Reviser publishes notice, LCB sends notice to rules distribution list
January 18, 2012	Public hearing held
January 18, 2012	End of written comment period
January 25, 2012	Board is asked to adopt rules
January 25, 2012	Agency sends notice to those who commented both at

	the public hearing and in writing.
January 25, 2012	Agency files adopted rules with the Code Reviser (CR 103)
February 25, 2012	Rules are effective (31 days after filing)
