2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION UPDATE Marc Webster, Director of Legislative Relations

Marc noted that the two agency request bills had passed, and updated on several other bills that have made their way through the legislative process and will impact the agency.

CHEMICAL TESTING UPDATE

Rick Garza, Director; Chandra Wax, Director of Enforcement and Education

Chandra updated on the emergent issue on chemical testing in North Central Washington. Results of random testing revealed some areas above the 0.1 action limit in WAC for DDE in the Brewster area. Some results from tests of on-shelf products have also come back above the action limit. Several meetings between agencies, staff, and stakeholders have been occurring to identify the best path forward.

RESEARCH POSITION REVIEW Justin Nordhorn, Director of Policy and External Affairs

Justin provided background into the creation of a research program in order to obtain neutral and objective scientific information to aid in decision making when complex issues are presented. The proposed three-member team would be a centralized unit that supports all of the divisions and be a dedicated resource to collect and analyze data.
