

Notice of Preproposal Statement of Inquiry WSR 25-14-034

The Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (LCB) has filed a pre-proposal statement of inquiry (CR-101) to consider amending WAC 314-55-102 to expand heavy metal testing requirements to all cannabis products. This rulemaking addresses a petition for rulemaking accepted by the Board in January 2024. Currently only Department of Health (DOH) compliant medical cannabis products are required to be tested for heavy metals under WAC 246-70-050.

The LCB encourages your input on this rulemaking. Following the CR-101 comment period, the agency will distribute and publish a CR-102 with proposed rules, establish a formal comment period consistent with chapter 34.05 RCW on the proposed rules, and hold a public hearing before the final rules are adopted.

Please send your comments on the CR-101 to the Board through mail, e-mail, or fax by **July 25**, **2025**. The CR-102 with proposed rules is anticipated to be filed in 2026, following collaborative rule development.
