**Subject of possible rule making:** Title 314 WAC. The Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (Board) is considering repealing, amending, and creating rule sections as necessary, including WAC 314-55-310 on cannabis transportation licenses, to consider allowing cannabis transportation licensees to cross-dock at a distribution fulfillment hub, as requested in a Petition for Rulemaking accepted by the Board in September 2024.

**Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:** RCW 69.50.342; RCW 69.50.345.

**Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:** Amendments to and repeal of existing rules, as well as the creation of new rules in Chapter 314-55 WAC may be necessary to address a Petition for Rulemaking accepted by the Board in September 2024 on cannabis transportation licenses, seeking to allow them to cross-dock.
