"Hemp-Derived THC Products"

Products derived from hemp (as defined by the 2018 Farm Bill) but contain detectable levels of THC and is illegal to sell in Washington State outside of regulated cannabis retail stores.

Isomers vs. Derivatives

Analog


A compound having a similar structure to another compound; includes both isomers and derivatives

Isomer

Same number of carbons, hydrogens, and oxygens, but rearranged. For example: Delta-8 vs. Delta-9 vs. Delta-10

Derivative


Looks like Delta-9-THC, but has a different number of carbons, hydrogens and oxygens. For example: HHC, THC-O, or THC-P



Any combination of these changes are possible, producing molecules that look similar to Delta-9-THC with unknown effects and safety. Thousands of THC-like compounds can be formed (e.g., HHC-O, Delta-10-THCH, Delta-8-THCP-O).




Between 77-87% of people include these products when reporting about their cannabis use







ALL PRODUCTS ARE DERIVED FROM HEMP AND CONTAIN LESS THAN 0.3% Δ 9THC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2018 FARM BILL.

- Oregon purchased online and in-store hemp products.
- All 51 samples of hemp flower tested exceeded 0.3% total THC and is prohibited for sale to Oregon consumers.
- Hemp flower ranged from 0.4% to 30.5% total THC.

Prevalence and Current Issues

- Becoming more prevalent
- Youth access
- Industry driving action
 - Industry members concerned out of state is taking business from our licensees
- Products with 0.3% allowed in some states without a license but not in Washington

Investigations and Actions Taken

- May attempt to purchase
- Cease and desist letter
- Contact local jurisdiction
 - *Depending on circumstances

Challenges

- Enforcement resources and capacity
- Ability to get prosecution
 - Depending on location
- Out of Country (Mexico, Canada or even China even more difficult)
- Time
 - Investigating complaint
 - Attempting to purchase
 - Waiting for product
- Cease and desist letter could be easily ignored
