At 10:00 am, Dustin Dickson announced that the meeting lobbies were open, and the recording had begun.

At 10:00 am, Chair Postman convened the meeting.

### REVIEW AND DISCUSSION OF THC BILL – Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill (E2SSB) 5367 Jennifer Dzubay, Captain, Enforcement

Captain Dzubay spoke about the impacts of Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill (E2SSB) 5367 which was introduced to address the increasing prevalence of hemp-derived THC products. Synthetic THC compounds converted from hemp have led to a rapid expansion of THC products in the unregulated market, which created challenges for the Enforcement team. Products with detectable THC are illegal in Washington, so Dzubay talked about the training and tools that Enforcement uses and actions they have taken while trying to keep those products off the market.

#### POLICY AND RULES TEAM UPDATES AND BOARD MEETING PREP General Updates – Cassidy West, Policy and Rules Manager

Cassidy provided general updates and timeline items.

Rules Petition Review and Consideration Requesting to Amend WAC 314-55-310 to Allow Cannabis Transportation Licensees to Cross-Dock at Their Own Fulfillment Hubs to Organize Shipments – Cassidy West, Policy and Rules Manager

Cassidy previewed a petition for adoption, amendment, or repeal of WAC 314-55-310 governing transportation licenses to permit "cross-docking" of cannabis and cannabis products at a distribution fulfillment hub owned by the licensee.

### Board Adoption of CR 103 for Substitute House Bill (SHB) 1453 – Medical Cannabis Patient Excise Tax Exemption Implementation – Daniel Jacobs, Policy and Rules Coordinator

Daniel briefed on a CR 103 to implement SHB 1453 which provides an exemption to the 37% excise tax levied on medical cannabis purchases under certain conditions.

### Public Hearing on Cannabis Payment Flexibility – Daniel Jacobs, Policy and Rules Coordinator

Daniel previewed a public hearing regarding a CR 102 for Cannabis Payment Flexibility to allow the mailing of checks up to three days after delivery, for transactions where cannabis licensees purchase cannabis from other licensees.

# Public Hearing Regarding CR 102 for Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill (E2SSB) 5367 Concerning the Regulation of Products Containing THC – Cassidy West, Policy and Rules Manager

Cassidy previewed a public hearing regarding a CR 102 to amend sections of 314-55 WAC to implement E2SSB 5367 to address the prevalence and complexity of products containing hemp-derived THC.

## Public Hearing Regarding CR 102 for Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill (E2SSB) 5080 Expanding and Improving the Social Equity in Cannabis Program – Cassidy West, Policy and Rules Manager

Cassidy presented information on a public hearing regarding a CR 102 to amend WAC 314-55-570 to implement E2SSB 5080, related to expanding and improving the social equity in cannabis program.

### **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE Marc Webster, Director of Legislative Relations**

Marc presented two potential agency-request bills for the Board's consideration. The first is from the Licensing division to clarify when and where Mandatory Alcohol Server Training (MAST) permits are required and to clarify statute by removing obsolete or unused permits and licenses. The second is an information sharing bill related to last year's medical cannabis excise tax
