LCB Rulemaking Activity

About the Rulemaking Process: The rulemaking process is outlined in the Administrative Procedures Act ([Chapter 34.05 RCW](#)), and typically involves three official phases: inquiry, proposal, and adoption. The rule development process may take months to years to complete, depending on staff resources, project complexity, data or information availability, and public interest.

About This Dashboard: This dashboard provides a snapshot of rulemaking activity for the Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (LCB), including open rule projects, recently submitted petitions, and recently completed rules. The goal of this dashboard is to increase transparency of current rule activity to promote increased accessibility and rule participation across Washington communities.
