



Bill Title: Wine Auction Permit

Bill Number: HB 1718

Effective Date: July 23, 2017

Amends: RCW 66.20.010

Summary:

Creates a wine auction permit.

- The permit is issued to a nonprofit organization.
- The application for an auction permit must be submitted prior to the event.
- The permit allows the nonprofit organization to sell wine through a private auction not open to the public.
- The permit is for a specific place and a specific date.
- The permit authorizes the holder to conduct wine tastings at the auction of the wine to be auctioned at the event.
- The permit allows wine sales for off-premises consumption.
- Wine from multiple wineries may be sold at the auction:
 - Each winery must be listed on the auction permit application.
- The fee per event for an auction permit is \$25 multiplied by the number of wineries that are selling wine at the auction.

How to Apply:

- Complete a Wine Auction Permit Application. Information can be found on the WSLCB website at <http://lcb.wa.gov/licensing/permits>.
- Application is received by a Customer Service Specialist and you will be contacted if further information is needed.
- Customer Service Specialist will issue the permit and email it to the applicant when applicable.
