

Bill Title: Liquor Privileges--Students

Bill Number: EHB 1563

Effective Date: July 28, 2019

Amends: RCW 66.24.010, RCW 66.44.318

## Summary

This bill:

- Allows colleges and universities that have a special permit under RCW 66.20.010 (12) to include off-campus tasting at a grape-growing or production facility to the already-allowed on-campus tasting by students at least eighteen years of age
  - Students tasting alcoholic beverages while on a field trip must be accompanied and supervised by a faculty or staff member with a class 12 or 13 alcohol server permit
- Allows domestic wineries to have their student interns between the ages of eighteen and twenty-one engage in wine production-related work at the domestic winery's licensed location
  - Interns must be enrolled at a college or university that holds a special permit under RCW 66.20.010
  - The intern must be enrolled in a required or elective class as part of a degree program identified in RCW 66.20.010 (12) (b)
- Requires the domestic winery be responsible for acts or omissions by the intern that violate Title 66 RCW
