

1.37.5 Manifest Process Change Impacts

Release 1.37.5 has a variety of updates that will impact all system users. These changes and impacted parties are listed below:

- Issue: **The ability to track 'origin' / 'propagation source' of plant from sender to receiver.**
 - Impacted parties: state users, producer/processors
 - What the update means: As packaged plants are transferred from one facility to another, they maintain their original "propagation source" value.

- Issue: **Upon creation of an inventory transfer at a retail facility, the incorrect recipient value is saved.**
 - Impacted parties: retail
 - What the update means: Intended recipients can correctly be selected on inventory transfers made by retailers.

- Issue: **Transfer from lab to lab can be completed with no restrictions.**
 - Impacted parties: testing lab users
 - What the update means: Inventory can be transferred from one lab to another without restrictions to support the "Lab Test Outsourcing" workflow.

- Issue: **Validation for 'global_id'**
 - Impacted parties: state users, producer/processors, testing lab users, retail
 - What the update means: Users should be able to search for the full inventory transfer global ID and have the record returned. If the record does not exist, an error message will display, indicating "No record found."

- Issue: **Invalid data error messaging upon submission of duplicate 'global_id' values.** (When a transfer is created with multiple inventor lots with the same global ID, a non-descriptive error message is returned.)
 - Impacted parties: producer/processors, state users, testing lab users, retail
 - What the update means: Multiple inventory lots with the same global ID will cause the call to fail, and a descriptive error message will be returned.

- Issue: **Inventory type ID is not automatically created.** (Upon receipt of inventory, the system is not accurately creating a correctly associated inventory type.)
 - Impacted parties: producer/processors, retail
 - What the update means: Upon receipt of inventory, the receiving facility will have an appropriate inventory type automatically created by the system.

- Issue: **Modifying price on inventory transfer adds an additional sale record.**
 - Impacted parties: producer/processors, state users, testing lab users, retail
 - What the update means: Additional sale records will not be created in the system when a transfer is updated.

- Issue: **When a transfer is voided, the associated sale should be voided too.**
 - Impacted parties: producer/processors, testing lab users, retail
 - What the update means: When an inventory transfer record is voided, the associated sale record is also voided.

- Issue: **Unable to transfer from lab to lab with partial results associated.**
 - Impacted parties: testing lab users
 - What the update means: Inventory with partial lab results can be transferred from one lab to another without restrictions to support the “Lab Test Outsourcing” workflow.

- Issue: **Unable to transfer to a different lab for test results.**
 - Impacted parties: testing lab users
 - What the update means: Inventory can be transferred from one lab to another without restrictions to support the “Lab Test Outsourcing” workflow.
