

## Bills on track to passing Legislature

<b>Tobacco and Vapor Products</b>		
HB 1074	Tobacco 21	Raises age for tobacco sales to age 21; Gov consultation with Tribes regarding raising age of sale in compacts; Report on status Dec 2020
1873/5986	Vapor taxes	37% excise tax; 10 cents/ml; both authorize contracts with Tribes
<b>Marijuana</b>		
HB 1094	Medical renewal	Compassionate care renewal of medical authorization without having to appear in person with health care provider
HB 1095	Medical students	Authorizes use of marijuana-infused products by medical patient students at school, school buses and school-sponsored events
HB 1792	Penalties sale to minors	Reduces from felony to misdemeanor the criminal penalty for selling marijuana to minors
HB 2052	Testing lab	Authority to accredit marijuana testing labs transferred to Department of Ecology in 2024
HB 1415	Medical database	Transfers funding source for administration of medical marijuana database to Marijuana Account from Health Professional Account
HB 1794	Intellectual property	Authorizes marijuana businesses to enter contracts for intellectual property, payment of royalties; eliminates required disclosure of all contracts to LCB
SB 5298	Labeling	Authorizes statements regarding function or purpose of marijuana products; warning/disclosure required similar to dietary supplements
SB 5318	Enforcement	Revises process for marijuana enforcement; compliance and technical assistance program created; certain penalties reduced
SB 5605	Prior convictions	Requires courts to vacate prior misdemeanor marijuana possession convictions if offender was at least 21 years of age
<b>Alcohol</b>		
HB 1034	Soju endorsement	Creates a soju endorsement for spirits, beer and wine restaurant licenses; authorizes servers to leave open bottle at table
HB 1557	License process	Provides conditional liquor licenses; revises expiration dates of licenses and prorated fee provisions
HB 1672	Re-corking	Winery patrons may re-cork unused portions of bottles; sake at restaurants also included
HB 1563	Student tasting	Authorizes students in certain alcohol-related college degree programs and interns to taste at wineries, manufacturing locations
SB 5394	Web sites	Allows liquor licensees to provide more information about events and ticket on social media and websites
SB 5909	Packaging	Authorizes alcohol manufacturers to perform bottling and packaging services
SB 5549	Distillers	Authorizes distilleries to open additional
