Farmers Market Pilot Locations

Alan Rathbun, Licensing Director, presented that SHB 1172 which was passed in the 2011 legislative session allowed for a pilot program for beer and wine tastings in qualified farmers' markets. Out of the 59 qualified farmers markets, 40 were interested in being a part of the pilot and were then divided into seven regions. Joel Watts of the Farmer's Market Association and Dora Duval, Retail Services Manager, selected those chosen by random drawing. Those selected for the pilot program were: Wenatchee Valley, Pasco, Vancouver, Everett, Vashon, Proctor, Magnolia, West Seattle, and Pike Place. Two alternates, Kittitas and Columbia City, were also selected.
