**Subject:** Request for approval to rescind Board Interim Policy (BIP) 01-2018 concerning food service requirements for spirits, beer, and wine restaurants (WAC 314-02-035)

On February 21, 2018, the Board approved Board Interim Policy 01-2018 to recognize and honor the cultural diversity of food offerings in licensed spirits, beer, and wine restaurants, and associated shifts in business models. Specifically, BIP 01-2018 amended WAC 314-02-035 in the following ways:

- Expanded the definition of “complete meal” to provide that side dishes could be served with an entrée, but were not required.
- Expanded the definition of “entrée” to reflect greater diversity by adding examples such as pho, tikka, masala, and quiche.

BIP 01-2018 was designed to be rescinded upon the adoption of rules to make the BIP permanent. Permanent rules were adopted on June 14, 2018 as WSR #18-13-063. As a result, BIP 01-2018 is no longer necessary.

If the Board approves rescission of BIP 01-2018, the agency will send notice to stakeholders, and remove the BIP from the LCB website.

The Board approves/disapproves the rescission of BIP 01-2018.
