

Number of Complaints by Industry












#### Education Contact Breakdown
















# Delivery / Curbside Compliance: Youth Access




Compliance Checks ——Compliance Rate


## Cannabis Compliance: Youth Access




# Tobacco and Vapor Compliance: Youth Access






