CR 103 and adopted rules are filed with the Office of the Code Reviser.  LCB webpage updated and notice circulated by GovDelivery distribution list.
October 27, 2023	Rules are effective 31 days after filing, unless otherwise specified. See RCW 34.05.380(2).
