Greetings Region 4 Marijuana Retailers!

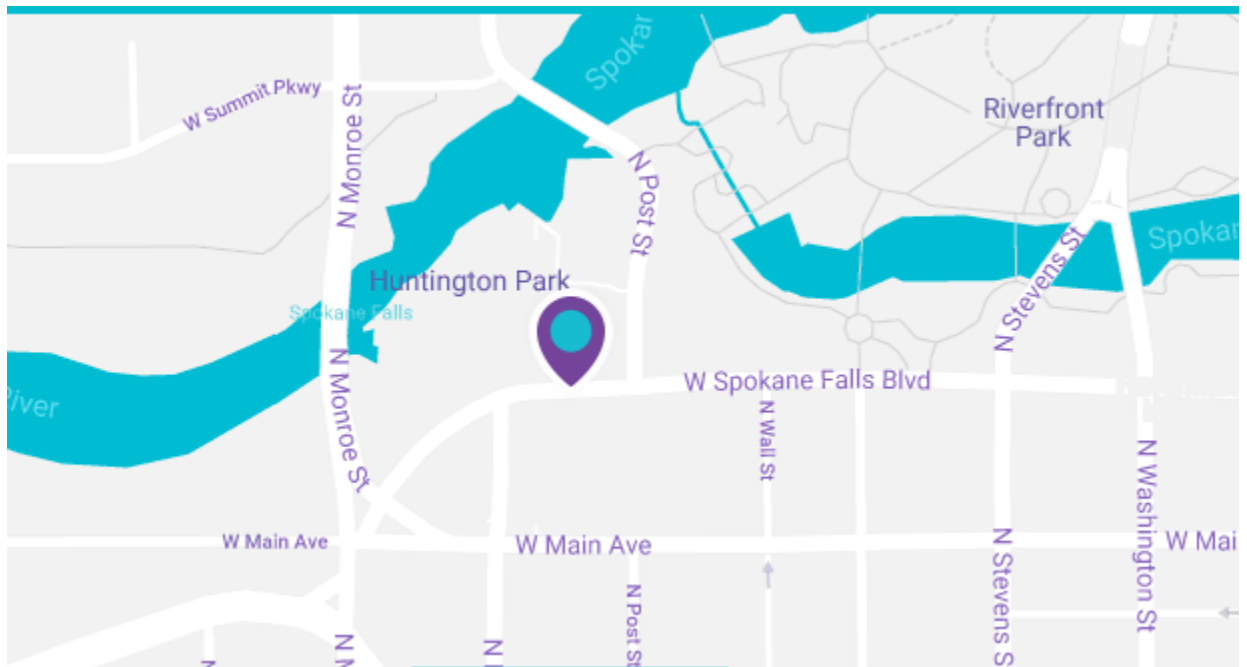
Based upon your **survey feedback** we are hosting four separate trainings days in Spokane on both the new **Marijuana Advertising** rule changes and **Responsible Cannabis Sales (RCS)**.

Please review the below training descriptions to determine who should attend which training class. We have staggered the training classes to allow maximum participation and convenience - each training is about 1-hour in length.

**The Responsible Cannabis Sales (RCS)** is designed to help front line retail marijuana store security and sales clerks (budtenders) learn how to read state identification in order to prevent minors from purchasing cannabis products or frequenting retail marijuana shops. It also covers ways to prevent other public safety violations.

The **Marijuana Advertising** training is designed to help retail marijuana store licensees and/or managers understand and comply with recently adopted state laws and rules around outdoor advertising of cannabis.
