## PENALTIES for clerks

Sale of cigarettes/tobacco products to anyone under 21\*

\*Sale of a vapor product to someone under 21: \$50 each offense

Selling tobacco or vapor products to people under age 21 is a gross misdemeanor. That means it's a crime which carries fines, criminal charges, or both. (Chapter 26.28.080 RCW, Chapter 70.345 RCW, ESSB 1074)
