Sale of cigarettes/tobacco products to a minor*

\$200.....Subsequent offenses

*Sale of a vapor product to a minor: \$50 each offense

Selling tobacco or vapor products to people under age 18 is a **gross misdemeanor.** (RCW 26.28.080) That means it's a **crime** which carries **fines, criminal charges, or both.**
