This rulemaking clarifies the process and criteria for local governments to petition the Board for creation of an Alcohol Impact Area. Steve Gano, MillerCoors commented on how the industry is pleased with the tightening of the rules. Member Bremer made a motion to approve. Member Kurose seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Adoption of Rules on 314-13-030 - Retail License, Purchasing Spirits from the Board

Karen McCall requested the adoption of the rules which would allow the Liquor Control Board to accept bank credit and debit cards for purchases in state liquor stores. Member Bremer made a motion to approve the adoption of the rules. Member Kurose seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Phil Wayt, Washington Beer and Wine Wholesalers Association, requested the Board initiate rulemaking which would allow wine distributors to authorize the imposition of a service charge for handling individual bottles of wine.
