The regular meeting of the Washington State Liquor Control Board was called to order at 10:00 am, on Wednesday, July 11, 2007 in the board room, 3000 Pacific Avenue S.E., Olympia, Washington, by Board Chairman Lorraine Lee. Board Member Roger Hoen and Board Member Ruthann Kurose were present.

Purchasing Services Division – Debi Besser, Purchasing Division Director, made recommendations as explained in the attached memos.

The Board members unanimously approved Ms. Besser's recommendations, The Board members also approved sending a recognition letter to the supplier that will be dedicating 100% of the proceeds on one of its products to charity.

Healthy Youth Survey Presentation -- Dr. Linda Becker, DASA, Dept. of Social and Health Services, gave a presentation on the results of the 2006 Healthy Youth Survey conducted in Washington State. This survey has been used since 1988 and has been administered every two years to 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students in the schools. The survey's purpose is to gather data on adolescent health behaviors, including alcohol consumption. In 2006, 198,312 students took this survey. (See attached power point presentation.) Several state agencies use the survey results.
