(1) On or about October 28, 2010, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, engaged in or permitted conduct on the licensed premise that is prohibited by RCW 69.50.401(1), to wit: delivery of methamphetamine, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(e); and

(2) On or about November 16, 2010, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, engaged in or permitted conduct on the licensed premise that is prohibited by RCW 69.50.401(1), to wit: delivery of methamphetamine, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(e); and

(3) On or about June 2, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof, engaged in or permitted conduct on the licensed premise that is prohibited by RCW 69.50.401(1), to wit: delivery of methamphetamine, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(e); and


1 (4) On or about June 2, 2011, the above-named Licensee, or an employee thereof,
2 engaged in or permitted conduct on the licensed premise that is prohibited by RCW
3 9A.56.310(1) to wit: possessing a stolen firearm, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(e); **or in the**
4 **alternative** RCW 9.41.040 to wit: possessing a firearm after having been convicted of a
5 serious offense, contrary to WAC 314-11-015(3)(e).

6 The penalty to be imposed for the above stated charges is cancellation of the liquor
7 license, per WAC 314-29-020.

14 The above-entitled matter having come on before the Washington State Liquor Control
15 Board (Board) pursuant to RCW 66.08.150(4), and the Board having reviewed the materials
16 submitted by the Enforcement Division in this matter, now hereby enters the following
17 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Emergency Order of Suspension:

18 **I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

19 The Board has received and reviewed copies of the following:

1.5 Administrative Violation Notice 1L1215A and the documents in support thereof, establish that the Licensee or employees thereof have allowed or engaged in conduct that presents a serious threat to public safety and have actively permitted or engaged in criminal conduct on the licensed premise on three separate occasions.

1.6 Administrative Violation Notice 1L1215A and the documents in support thereof, and the Licensee's licensing history, establish that the Licensee and/or its employees are unwilling or incapable of complying with the Washington State Liquor Act and/or the Revised Rules and Regulations of the Liquor Control Board and/or the criminal laws of the state of Washington.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2.1 The Washington State Liquor Act, contained in Title 66 RCW, and the duly promulgated Revised Rules and Regulations of the Board, contained in Title 314 WAC, were created for the protection of the welfare, health, peace, morals, and safety of the people of the state of Washington. *See* RCW 66.08.010.

1 2.2 Pursuant to RCW 66.08.150(4), the Board may summarily suspend a liquor
2 license for a period of up to one-hundred eighty (180) days, without a prior hearing, when the
3 Board finds that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively requires emergency action.

4 2.3 The Board, after reviewing the foregoing materials, and being in the premises fully
5 advised, concludes that the incidents occurring on the above-identified licensed premises are
6 contrary to public policy and law, and hereby finds that the public health, safety and/or welfare
7 imperatively requires emergency action.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the Board's emergency powers as authorized by
9 RCW 66.08.150(4),


10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DIRECTED:**

11 I. That the liquor license privileges of EL CLUB, INC., d/b/a EL PARRAL located
12 at 704 Main Street, Vancouver, Washington 98660-3161, are hereby suspended for a period of up
13 to one-hundred eighty (180) days, effective from August 10, 2011, at 4:00 p.m. to February 5,
14 2012, at 4:00 p.m.

15 II. That the liquor license privileges of the licensees be thereafter revoked, subject to
16 any lawful appeal exercised by the Licensee.
