- 2.2 Pursuant to RCW 66.08.150(4), the Board may summarily suspend a liquor license for a period of up to one-hundred eighty (180) days, without a prior hearing, when the Board finds that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively requires emergency action.
- 2.3 The Board, after reviewing the foregoing materials, and being in the premises fully advised, concludes that the incidents occurring on the above-identified licensed premises are contrary to public policy and law, and hereby finds that the public health, safety and/or welfare imperatively requires emergency action.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the Board's emergency powers as authorized by RCW 66.08.150(4),

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DIRECTED:

- I. That the liquor license privileges of EL CLUB, INC., d/b/a EL PARRAL located at 704 Main Street, Vancouver, Washington 98660-3161, are hereby suspended for a period of up to one-hundred eighty (180) days, effective from August 10, 2011, at 4:00 p.m. to February 5, 2012, at 4:00 p.m.
- II. That the liquor license privileges of the licensees be thereafter revoked, subject to any lawful appeal exercised by the Licensee.
