



NOTICE OF RULE MAKING – Pre-proposal - #18-14

The Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board has entered into the initial stage of rule making (CR 101) to implement House Bill 2517 which passed during the 2018 legislative session. Rulemaking will revise chapter 314-29 WAC to implement a schedule of penalties for a licensed alcohol manufacturer who has committed a violation as part of the licensee's ancillary activities.

There are no proposed rules at this stage of rulemaking. The Liquor and Cannabis Board encourages you to give input on what you feel should be contained in these rules. Following the comment period, the agency will send out and publish the proposed rules, establish a comment period on the proposed rules, and hold a public hearing before the rules are adopted.
