

PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY

CR-101 (June 2004)

(Implements RCW 34.05.310)
Do NOT use for expedited rule making

Agency: Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board

Subject of possible rule making: The Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (WSLCB) is considering rule changes in Chapter 314-55 WAC as a result of changes to laws that will occur due to bills passed during the 2017 Legislative Session. Other technical, clarifying, and needed changes to rules identified by staff and stakeholders will be addressed, incorporating the CR-101 filed as WSR 16-15-035 into this rulemaking. Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 69.50.342 and 69.50.345. Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Rules must be consistent with changes to laws passed by the Legislature. Several bills were passed during the 2017 Legislative Session that require adjustments to rules and direct the WSLCB to engage in rulemaking. Additionally, other changes to rules may be proposed to ensure that rules are clear and accurately reflect agency intent, and to address needed changes identified by staff and stakeholders in this developing industry. Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies: Coordination with the Washington State Department of Health and the Washington State Department of Agriculture may be necessary. The WSLCB will consult and partner with these agencies as appropriate.
