



**Bill Title:** Services by Liquor Manufacturers

**Bill Number:** SB 5909

**Effective Date:** July 28, 2019

**Amends:** RCW 66.24.150

### **Summary**

This bill:

- Allows liquor manufacturers to contract with distilleries, breweries, and wineries to provide packaging services that include, but are not limited to:
  - Canning, bottling, and bagging of alcoholic beverages
  - Mixing products before packaging
  - Receiving and returning products to the originating liquor licensed businesses as part of a contract
- Does not allow manufacturers to contract directly or indirectly with any retail liquor licensee for the sale of alcohol products unless they are medicinal, culinary, or toilet preparations not usable as beverages as described in RCW 66.12.070 (toilet and culinary preparations may contain perfumes, lotions or flavorings that include alcohol)
- Does not allow manufacturers to sell directly to retail liquor licensees, except for the sale of medicinal, culinary or toilet preparations containing alcohol
- Prohibits manufacturers from mixing or infusing THC, CBD, or any other cannabinoid into any product containing alcohol
