



## NOTICE OF RULE MAKING – Pre-proposal WSR # 19-12-044

The Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board has entered into the initial stage of rule making (CR 101) to revise chapter 314-28 WAC – Distilleries.

Rules revisions are needed to allow distilleries and craft distilleries to share space for production under an alternating proprietorship agreement. Revisions will ensure clear requirements are in place for alternating proprietorships.

Additional technical and clarifying changes will be made if necessary.

There are no proposed rules at this stage of rulemaking. The Liquor and Cannabis Board encourages you to give input on what you feel should be contained in these rules.
