- Share and discuss conceptual draft rules regarding the Social Equity in Cannabis Program with LCB industry partners and other interested partners and parties;

Why are we here?

- In late October 2021, while awaiting recommendations from the Social Equity in Cannabis Task Force (Task Force), the LCB began to consider amendments to existing rule and new rules that would both support and establish the Social Equity in Cannabis program. The CR 101, or Statement of Inquiry, was filed as WSR 21-22-042 on October 27, 2021.
- The Task Force released recommendations on January 6, 2022, and the agency began to draft rules based on those recommendations.

How will data be collected, shared, and presented to decision makers?

- Comments received will be added to an Excel workbook, organized by theme, and analyzed.
- Comments will be presented to the Board for review and discussion.
- Workbook will be published on LCB website at a later date.

Basic Rule Making Process


The standard rule making process is described in chapter 34.05 RCW, the Administrative Procedures Act, and divided into three stages:


- Stage 1: Pre-proposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) RCW 34.05.310
- Stage 2: Proposed Rule Making (CR-102) RCW 34.05.320
- State 3: Rule-making Order (CR-103) RCW 34.05.360

Each stage consists of specific tasks and processes.
