



NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES - WSR 23-16-146

The Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (LCB) invites your input on proposed rules (CR 102) to implement 2023 Legislation Engrossed Substitute House Bill (ESHB) 1731 ([chapter 257, Laws of 2023](#)), which created a new permit to allow short term rental operators to provide complimentary bottles of wine to renters 21 and over, so long as the renters are advised of certain alcohol laws, told in advance that a complimentary bottle will be provided, and given an opportunity to decline the complimentary wine. Short term rental operators are also permitted to acquire wine directly from wine distributors for use related to this permit.
