Subject: Approval to file a pre-proposal statement of inquiry (CR 101)

regarding Employee Stock Ownership Plans (ESOP).

The Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (Board) is considering amending <u>WAC 314-55-035</u> and other sections of Title 314 WAC, as well as repealing or creating other sections of Title 314 WAC as necessary to allow the use of Employee Stock Ownership Plans (ESOP) in connection with cannabis licenses in response to a petition for rulemaking accepted in May 2024.

Process

The Policy and Rules Coordinator requests approval to file the pre-proposal statement of inquiry (CR 101) for the rule making described above. A CR 101 Memorandum was presented at the Board meeting on October 9, 2024 and is attached to this order.
